

## NOMINATIONS FOR MASTER

Reference the Laws and Rules Governing the Fourth Degree of the Knights of Columbus, Article V, Section 14, (c). District Masters are required to hold a Biennial Meeting of the District Assembly during the months of March or April of even numbered years. At this meeting, three candidates are to be selected for recommendation for the position of District master (this applies even if the District Master is to be recommended for reappointment). The selection of a candidate or the sequence in which recommended is not a guarantee of selection by the Supreme Master.

The District Master should forward the required information to the Vice Supreme Master, with the required biographies, as soon as possible after the conclusion of the Biennial Meeting. Letters in support of a candidate may be mailed to the Supreme Master's office.

In addition to the biography, each candidate must include a synopsis (not to exceed two double spaced typed pages) answering the two questions: "Why I am the best candidate for the position." and "What is my plan to promote and grow the Fourth Degree."

All candidates will be reviewed by both the District Master and Vice Supreme Master with their recommendations to the Supreme Master. The final recommendation is sent to the Supreme Knight so that the appointments can be effective September 1, 2020. Therefore we ask that all required forms, biographies and statements be sent by the District Master to the Vice Supreme Master **no later than May 1, 2020**.
